

**TOWN OF ALTONA
BY-LAW NO. 1605/2004**

Being a By-law to provide for smoke free and tobacco free buildings.

WHEREAS section 232(1)(a) of The Municipal Act, authorizes a Council of a Municipality to pass by-laws "the safety, health, protection and well-being of people, and the safety and protection of property;"


AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Altona, deems the use of tobacco products dangerous to the health of residents and employees therein;

AND WHEREAS Researchers and Physicians have found that the smoke from tobacco products is injurious to the health of the smoker as well as to persons occupying and/or working in the room with a person that smokes tobacco products;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Town of Altona, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT we prohibit the use of tobacco products by any person(s) or employee(s) in any buildings owned or operated by the Town of Altona.
2. THAT we authorize and direct the installation and placing of 'no smoking' signs and 'no use of tobacco products' signs within all buildings owned or operated by the Town of Altona.
3. THAT every person(s), employee(s) or organization(s) who contravenes or refuses, neglects, omits, or fails to obey or observe any provision of this by-law, is liable on summary conviction to a fine in accordance with the fine schedule as set out in the Town of Altona Fines and Penalties By-law.
4. THAT Town of Altona By-law No. 1501 be rescinded after the final passing of this by-law.
