

The Corporation of the Village of Lumby
Bylaw No. 793, 2017

A Bylaw to amend the Parks and Public Places Bylaw No. 669, 2007 to add enforcement ability in the event of unlawful activities.

WHEREAS Council may, by bylaw, regulate, prohibit and impose requirements in relation to the management of services, public places, nuisances, disturbances and other objectionable situations;

AND WHEREAS Council may, by bylaw, wish to regulate, prohibit, and impose requirements in relation to Village parks, recreation facilities, highways, and other public places;

THEREFORE The Council of the Corporation of the Village of Lumby, duly assembled in open Council, enacts as follows:

1. That section 15 of the Parks and Public Places Bylaw No. 669, 2007 be amended to the following:

“(o) smoking is prohibited on the Salmon Trail, within 7.5 metres of bus stops, in any park or green space including playgrounds, playing fields, spray park, pool, skate and/or bike park or trail. Notwithstanding this prohibition, the traditional use of tobacco in Aboriginal ceremonies in parks is permitted.

2. That the definition of “smoke or smoking” be amended in the Parks and Public Places Bylaw No. 669, 2007 as follows:

Interpretation

In this bylaw:

“**smoke or smoking**” means the inhaling, exhaling, burning or carrying of a lighted cigarette, vapour products including electronic cigarettes, cigar, pipe, hookah or other lighted smoking equipment burning tobacco or any other weed or substance.


3. This bylaw may be cited as the “Village of Lumby Parks and Public Places Amendment Bylaw No. 793, 2017.”
