

TOBACCO USE

Background

The District is cognizant of the serious health risks associated with the use of tobacco.

The District, therefore, supports programs which:

- > Increase awareness of the dangers associated with the use of tobacco; and
- Discourage the use of tobacco in all its forms.

The District directs that the use of tobacco is prohibited within all District facilities, within all District-owned/leased vehicles, on all District property and at all District-sponsored events.

Procedures

- 1. This Administrative Procedure shall apply to smoking and all other uses of tobacco.
- 2. This Administrative Procedure shall also be understood to prohibit all forms of tobacco advertising, including items such as brand name tobacco gear, paraphernalia and clothing.
- 3. Health-related programs at all levels shall incorporate instruction on the dangers associated with the use of tobacco and shall discourage tobacco use.
- 4. This Administrative Procedure shall apply to all users of District facilities and property, including students, employees, and visitors.
- 5. Appropriate signage shall be posted so as to inform users of District facilities, vehicles and property of the District Tobacco Use Administrative Procedure.
- 6. The Associate Superintendent Human Resources is responsible to advise candidates for employment of the District Tobacco Use Administrative Procedure.
- 7. With the prior approval of the Principal, the use of tobacco is permitted as part of religious/ceremonial events.
